PHSE and IAG at Key Stages 3 and 4

PHSE is taught through tutor time activities, super-learning days, normal lessons within subjects, assemblies and one-off events, depending upon the needs of the topic and year group. An overview for each year is given below. This is not exhaustive.

Year 7

Transition; school procedures; charity work; personal safety (child protection, road safety, safety on the beach etc) and e-safety; IAG – industrial awareness; A-Hero challenge; Endeavour challenge; social media and sexting

Year 8

Child protection; Childline; Alcohol, drugs, smoking and relationships; careers guidance and options for GCSE; charities

Year 9

Drugs, relationships, cigarettes and alcohol; Child protection; exploitation; internet safety; human rights; How Britain works; careers passport

Year 10

Teenage pregnancy, Sex education, healthy relationships, alcohol, smoking, drugs; citizenship; plagiarism; careers and future pathways; rights and responsibilities

Year 11

Relationships; careers guidance, CVs and applications
