Keep the ideas small: something realistic that covers a few moments in time are usually the most powerful narratives. Only include 1 or 2 characters and limit the amount of speech between them to avoid telling the story through dialogue.

To plan, I would suggest 5 minutes mindmapping any idea that comes to mind; see which one 'speaks to you' the most and branch off from there; then follow this with 5 minutes of sequencing your ideas through a list or a flowchart, so you are really thinking about the structure of your narrative: the order in which you tell the events of the story.

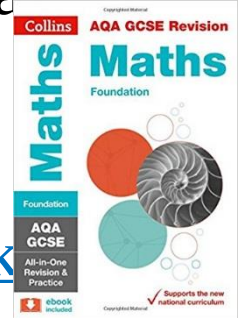
