Suggested revision activities

- Key sociologist lists - regular retrieval practice
- Exam question practice (timed and untimed)
- Key concept lists - regular retrieval practice
- Brain dump - What can you remember about a topic from memory? Then go through the section with your notes and add missed knowledge in a different colour. Then repeat this process to see if you can remember more each time.
- RAG rating of past exam questions - Practise these, starting with your least confident (red), then amber, then green.
- Thinking and linking activities - to help make connections between topics. This is something Miss Mallen does lots of in her lessons so use her templates.
- A good soft revision tool would be to watch the tutor2u videos on YouTube or watch the news or social documentaries that link to Ao2 examples covered in lessons.

The trick to revision is to do little and often. 20 minute bursts are ideal. You do not need to sit for hours and hours as this will not be effective. You will not be able to sustain the attention span you need so be realistic about how long you can revise for BUT plan what you are going to revise in advance and stick to it. Use your planners to help organise yourself.
