What is Erasmus + (Brief Overview)



• Erasmus+ is the European Union programme for education, training, youth and sport. It runs for seven years, from 2014 to 2020, with organisations invited to apply for funding each year to undertake creative and worthwhile activities.





Creative & Worthwhile Activities (Projects).



• Before a school can be part of the Erasmus + project, they have to look for partners schools in the European Union and apply for a grant in order to work on a common creative project.

• If the application is successful, a grant of up to about £30,000 can be offered to each participating schools to start the Erasmus project. This funding cover all the expenses for the 2 years Erasmus + project.



Previous Project – Phoenix



- Phoenix Erasmus project ran from September 2016 to August 2018.
- The school was offered £24,000 which was used to cover:
 - Cost of plane ticket for participants (4 students & 2 staff members)
 - Cost of hotel
 - Cost of pocket money (£20 a day for each participant)
 - Cost of transportation from Kings Lynn to the airport
 - Other expenses
- We worked with 5 other countries in the EU:
 - France
 - Italy
 - Germany
 - Greece
 - Spain

Logo competition



- Prepare a presentation showing:
 - 2 hand drawn ideas for the logo
 - 1 Hand drawn detailed plan of the logo to be made justifying your decisions showing:
 - Colour
 - Size
 - Sources of images to be imported
 - Fonts
 - At least 3 stages of development of the logo in a software package of your choice
 - Final logo saved as a .jpeg or .png format



Criteria

- Ability to resize without pixelating
- Eye catching
- Recognisable in colour or black/white
