Location

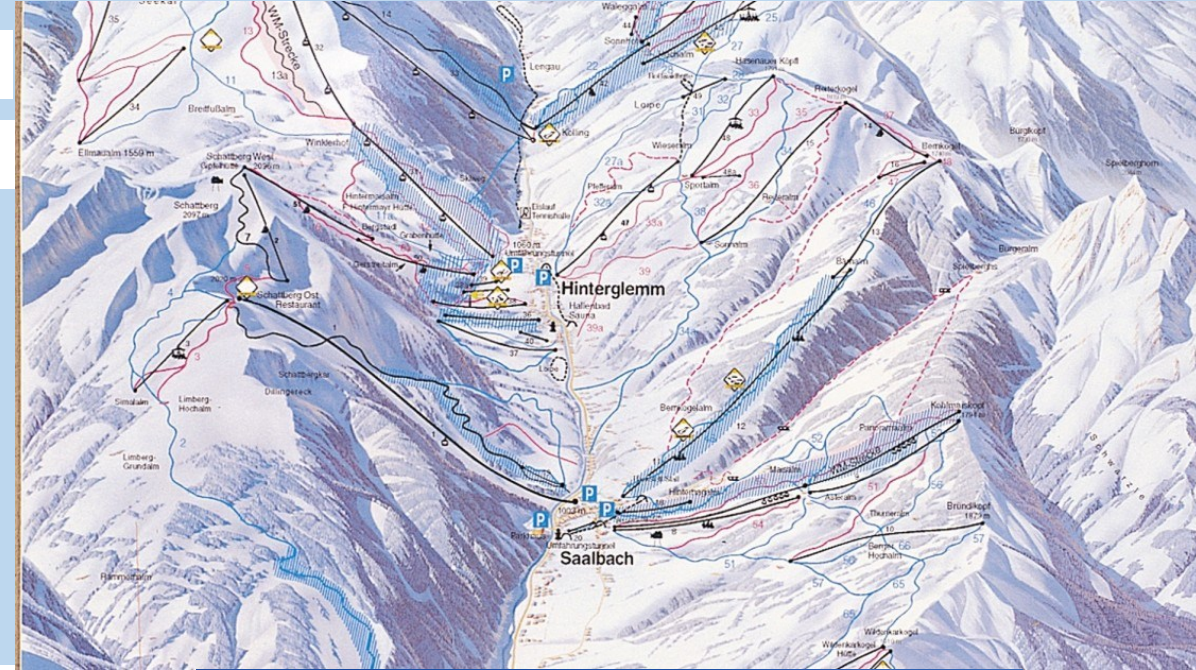
Equipment included for your skiing experience are:

If you are wanting to do snowboarding we need a minimum of 8 people to do it. And it also is provided with lessons if needed and a helmet, snowboard and boots.

The rest of the equipment such as the jacket, salinnets etc you will need to buy which are not expensive. We recommend you to buy all of this stuff during Summer while the deals and prices are cheaper.



Transport and Prices

We will be travelling by coach from Springwood on the 14th of February to Dover getting on the ferry to Calais, all the way to the resort, this will be a 20hour trip with stops for food and other needs, but this bus journey is one of the best parts..

Prices

This ski trip will cost £890 overall, the school are providing a payment plan, allowing you to be able to pay monthly which starts on June 30th until December. Snowboarding costs an additional £35.

You will also need to pay for the clothes and equipment needed in order to ski/snowboard. And we recommend you bring food or drink for the journey or bring money to pay for food at our stops.
