Good luck and keep up the good work. Mrs Williams




# 1-9 GCSE's and Progress 8

This year is the first year that there will be no A\* - G grades for GCSE's. Maths and English have had this in place for 2 years whilst the majority of subjects brought this in last year with; Sociology, Economics, Business Studies, Technology and Statistics bringing this in place for the first time.


