Academic Support: A number of teaching staff TLR responsibilities which contribute to the "narrowing the gap agenda". These include Operational Leadership team, Lead teacher KS3 and Lead teacher KS4. One member of the Senior Leadership Team. English, Maths and Science teachers teaching predominantly PP classes. Homework club staffing.
