N	<p>Numeracy and Literacy Complete your Timetable Rockstar activity. Read 4 books during Year 8 and create a brief report about them. <i>Gold standard: Either take part in a Maths challenge activity or review, in detail, 3 or more of the books you have read and email the reviews to your Tutor.</i></p>	- Monitoring in tutor time. - 4 book reports - typed <i>GS – Evidence from maths activity OR copy of email to tutor</i> Signature on Plan Sheet by form tutor
D	<p>Display Get your work displayed or publicised around the school in at least 3 different faculty areas or on the website or in the local press. <i>Gold standard: Produce a project about a topic that interests you which could be displayed at a Parents' Evening or similar event. This also counts for Gold Understand badge.</i></p>	-Collect evidence where possible. <i>GS – copy of project – signature by Mrs Courtman</i> Signature on Plan Sheet by three different teachers.
E	<p>Explore Attend three individual day trips or a residential activity with the school or other organisation. Write a short summary of each trip. <i>Gold standard: Produce an article for the school newsletter about a trip you have been on – contact Mrs Redman. Attend at least one performance in school as a member of the audience and write an article about that too.</i></p>	-Summary of each trip – typed <i>GS – copy of newsletter for both trip AND performance</i> Signature on Plan Sheet by form tutor
A	<p>ATLs Show excellence or significant improvement in your ATL grades on your reports in Year 7 and 8. <i>Gold standard: Achieve an average of ATL 1 for at least one report in the year during Year 8.</i></p>	Signature on Plan Sheet by form tutor
V	<p>Value Others Make a difference by taking an <u>active part</u> in organising and promoting a charity fund-raising event. <i>Gold standard: Organise your own charity fund-raising event.</i></p>	Signature on Plan Sheet by Ms Craig, Mr Hobbs or Mrs Courtman
O	<p>Orate Take an active part in presenting in an assembly, helping with a parents' evening or take part in a school performance during Yr 8. <i>Gold standard: Organise and lead an assembly to your House or Year group.</i></p>	<i>GS – speak to form tutor about available dates</i> Signature on Plan Sheet by member of staff involved in activity.
U	<p>Understand Complete your online safety project in Year 7 and your Careers project in Year 8 with at least an ATL 2. <i>Gold standard: Produce a project about a topic which interests you (in conjunction with Display).</i></p>	<i>GS – copy of project – signature by Mrs Courtman</i> Project seen by form tutor. Signature on Plan Sheet by form tutor
R	<p>Represent Represent your house in sports or school performance. AND Represent Springwood High School at a parents evening. <i>Gold standard: Represent your House, school or tutor group in 5 or more different activities.</i></p>	Signature by P.E teacher OR member of staff involved with performance. AND Signature by member of staff involved with parents evening.
