ENDEAVOUR

EExtra-Curricular Activity

Show that you have attended extra-curricular clubs, or outside school activities, at least 10 times between Easter of Year 7 and the end of Year 8.

The Gold Standard

Show that you have gone outside your comfort zone to try two brand new extra-curricular activities. You must demonstrate a regular commitment to these new activities. This is in addition to the first extra-curricular activity above.

ENDEAVOUR

Numeracy and Literacy

Complete your Timetable Rockstar challenge and gain at least one Literacy badge.

The Gold Standard

Either take part in a Maths challenge activity or gain a Blue literacy badge.

ENDEAVOUR

Display

Get your work displayed or publicised around the school in at least 3 different faculty areas or on the website or in the local press.

The Gold Standard

Produce a project about a topic that interests you which could be displayed at a Parents' Evening or similar event. See Guidance Sheet. This also counts for Gold Understand badge.

END EAVOUR

Explore

Attend three individual day trips or a residential activity with the school or other organisation.

The Gold Standard

Produce an article for the school newsletter about a trip you have been on. Attend at least one performance in school as a member of the audience and write an article about that too.

ENDEAVOUR

ATLs

Show excellence or significant improvement in your ATL grades on your reports in year 7 and 8.

The Gold Standard

Achieve an average of ATL 1 for at least one report in the year during year 8.

ENDEAVOUR

V alue Others

Make a difference by taking an active part in organising and promoting a charity fund-raising event.

The Gold Standard

Organise your own charity fund-raising event.

ENDEAVOUR

Orate

Take an active part in presenting in an assembly, helping with a parents evening, or take part in a school performance between Easter of Year 7 and the end of Year 8.

Organise and lead an assembly to your House or Year group.

Understand

Complete your online safety project in Year 7 and your Careers project in Year 8 with at least an ATL 2.

Produce a project about a topic which interests you (in conjunction with Display) – see guidance.
