Entry Requirements

Applicants should have achieved a L2 qualification in hairdressing have good communication skills, an interest in hair, beauty and fashion and take care with their appearance. Experience of working in a salon or with clients would be an advantage.

About the Course

VTCT Level 3 Diploma in Hairdressing

This course is aimed at students that have previously studied hairdressing at L2 and those wishing to have a career in the Hairdressing. Mature students that have worked in industry and want to take their skills/ knowledge to another level.

Course Duration - One year.

Course Content/Unit

Health and Safety, Client Consultation, Creatively cut hair using a combination of techniques, Promote additional services or products to customers, colour hair using a variety of techniques, provide colour correction services, creatively style and dress hair and creatively dress long hair.

Hair and Beauty Salon, a purpose built professional salon, providing a realistic working environment where treatments are performed on paying clients.

Guest lecturers from product companies, trips to professional trade exhibitions and competitions complement studies.

Students will be required to carry out practical assessments, written assignments, oral questioning and short online tests.
