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

To celebrate the *Only in England* exhibition (21<sup>st</sup> October 2017 until 15<sup>th</sup> April 2018) Time & Tide Museum invites photographers of all ages to take inspiration from the iconic photographic work by Tony Ray-Jones and Martin Parr featured in the exhibition, and share their own interpretations of East Anglia.

Tony Ray-Jones' and Martin Parr's photographs captured the honest, eccentric and at times peculiar aspects of British life. Sometimes energetic, at other times pensive, their work recorded the real life of real people in the 60's and 70's.
