



Springwood High School PTFA 100 Club

Welcome to our 100 Club – a great way to support us while having a bit of fun!

By joining, you're not only helping to fund resources, events, and enrichment opportunities for students, but also giving yourself the chance to win in our exciting prize draws.

Here's how it works...

You complete and sign the attached membership form and pay the annual membership of £24 by cash, bank transfer or card payment – that equates to £2 per month (£4 per draw).

Cash and card payments will only be accepted at events/school meetings where PTFA members will be available with application forms and the card machine.

This buys you one membership number (we will allocate), which enters you into the half-termly draw. You can buy as many numbers as you like - simply pay the corresponding amount for each additional number. For example, 1 number for the year is £24, 2 numbers for the year is £48, 3 numbers for the year is £72 and so on.

All participants must be over 16.

The draw will be held **six times throughout the academic year**, timed to take place **just before each school holiday** during the scheduled **PTFA** meetings (as published on the SHS website). For the 2026/27 academic year, draws will take place on

3 February 2027
17 March 2027
19 May 2027
14 July 2027

There will be a first, second and third prize winner for each draw.

If you win, it will be transferred to you via bank transfer and the names of the winners will be published in the PTFA minutes, Springwood High School (SHS) website, SHS newsletters and on Facebook.

The prize money will be 45% of the membership fee taken that month. The remaining 55% goes to the PTFA to help fund equipment, resources and extra-curricular activities/events for the school and students.

SHS PTFA 100 Club Rules including Payment Details

Purpose

The purpose of the SHS PTFA 100 Club is to raise funds for resources, events, and enrichment opportunities for students at Springwood High School. The money will be paid into the PTFA bank account and used to meet school funding requests and run events and extra-curricular activities.

Rules

1. For a cost of £4 per half term (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and *100 (*this may be increased depending on interest and uptake).
2. A draw will be made every half term (6 draws in total) with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The prizes will total 45% of the annual income.
4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 20%, 2nd prize of 15% and 3rd prize of 10% of the monthly income.
5. The SHS PTFA 100 Club is run as a small society lottery, registered with the local authority (King's Lynn & West Norfolk Borough Council).
6. Members must be aged 16 and above.
7. Payments can be made by either cash, card payment or bank transfer to:

8. For those opting to pay via bank transfer, member's bank transfer payment reference to be quoted is initial and surname with the prefix 100 so that payment can be identified, e.g.: 100AWinner.
9. Membership is for one academic year.
10. Member's numbers will only be entered if their membership is up to date.
11. The draw shall be made every half-term by the Springwood High School PTFA Committee during their scheduled meetings (as published on the SHS website).
12. The prize winnings will be paid via bank transfer to the bank details specified on your membership application within one week of the draw.
13. The name and numbers for draw winners will be published in the PTFA minutes, Springwood High School (SHS) website, SHS parent newsletters and on Facebook.

14. The SHS PTFA 100 Club will be run by the Springwood High School PTFA committee. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
15. Applications for membership throughout the year (mid-year) will be accepted on a pro-rata basis. The cost charged will be based on the number of future draws for that academic year.
16. Mid-year applications can be requested at school events/meetings where PTFA members are present, or by emailing 100club@springwoodhighschool.co.uk.
17. If a winner cannot be paid due to an account bounce back, the winnings will be placed into Springwood High School PTFA funds after six months has elapsed.
