Sociology	Booklets set fortnightly. These comprise a variety of tasks: Documentary watching and associated questions, producing fact files for key sociologists, short answer exam questions, retrieval tasks, and articles to read and answer questions on. This is as closely linked to what they are studying at the time or what they have recently done as possible. Students submit these on Google Classroom and receive feedback on there too. After Christmas, the booklets will then change to exam questions (10 markers to start and then increasing to 20/30 markers around easter).
