Dance	Homework will be weekly. The course is NEA based so every piece of homework will directly relate to completing one of their 7 units.

Psychology	Weekly homework on Uplearn (1 hour per week). In addition to this, there is a half termly exam question booklet which is self-assessed, reviewed by teacher, and whole class feedback is given.

Sociology	Booklets set fortnightly. These comprise a variety of tasks: Documentary watching and associated questions, producing fact files for key sociologists, short answer exam questions, retrieval tasks, and articles to read and answer questions on. This is as closely linked to what they are studying at the time or what they have recently done as possible. Students submit these on Google Classroom and receive feedback on there too. After Christmas, the booklets will then change to exam questions (10 markers to start and then increasing to 20/30 markers around easter). Work may also be set on seneca
