Summer Task Title / Instructions:

1. Speaking : Prepare a 5minute oral presentation – you can do this with visual aids/on powerpoint /using images. The topic must be :-

Either La Famille or French / francophone music

2. Writing : Film Review in French. Watch a French film/s (with English subtitles.) You can but do not have to choose one from those listed below. Write a short resumé in French of the storyline. Describe the setting / scenery, comment on the actors, describe particular scenes or incidents (good or bad) and give your own opinions.

Suggested films :-

La Haine : Mathieu Kassovitz.

Caché : Michael Haneke.

La Promesse : Jean-Pierre and Luc Dardenne.

Le dernier Métro or/ Les 400 coups: Francois Truffault

Un heros très discret : Jacques Audiard

Les Intouchables: Olivier Nakache & Éric Toledano

Or/ any French film of your choice.

Begin a log of all films watched with brief description of storyline / main actors etc.

3. Grammar booklet Complete exercises using different tenses and at least 2translations from back of booklet.

4. Reading : short story review - Read at least one short story in French (use the website below for ideas) and write a book review in French. <https://frenchtogether.com/french-short-stories/>

5. Listening: Listen to the French news using the website <https://www.newsinslowfrench.com/> a few times a week and make notes on what you have heard.

6. Additional practice: Use a range of websites to keep on top of your French revision and use any opportunity you have to read in French or watch French films and TV programmes. Read through the PIXL booklet and complete as much of it as you can.
