### Entry Requirements

3 GCSEs at grade 4 including English Lang & Maths. Good communication and practical skills are needed with an interest in bricklaying and the construction industry. Level 1/2 in construction the built environment or any level 1 from a construction course will help

### About the Course

#### **City and Guilds Level 2 Technical Certificate in Bricklaying (7905)**

This course is aimed at school leavers and those wishing to have a career in the construction industry as a bricklayer. Course Duration - One year.

#### **Course Content/Units**

Anybody interested in the level 2 Technical Certificate in bricklaying will study theoretical aspects of the trade and apply them to practical tasks. A wide range of practical jobs to build, and perfect your practical skills. Compulsory topics include:

- The principles of construction
- Building cavity walls
- Constructing basic arches
- Setting out buildings

### Assessment

To gain the qualification, students must successfully achieve the following assessments.

- One externally set, externally moderated assignment. (Practical)
- One externally set, externally marked exam, set under examination conditions (Theory)
- Employer engagement

#### **Additional Information**

Information regarding specific equipment required, days of attendance and enrolment date will be given at interview and advice and guidance sessions.

Practical Training Assessments run throughout the course, then a timed synoptic practical assessment on set dates along with an online exam. Employer engagement is necessary to achieve the qualification.
