Post 16 Travel Information

If you are planning to go to sixth form or college in September and will need transport you need to take action now. Do not wait until you get your results. If applications are received after 31 July it may be too late to arrange transport in time.

Most local bus and train operators offer discounted fares for students. The main deals and contact details for operators can be found here. You should check this before applying to Norfolk County Council as the fares and tickets offered are often cheaper than the Council's travel scheme.

If purchasing a ticket from an operator is not suitable, the County Council provides a subsidised Post16 Travel Scheme based on a network of core transport routes. There will be a core route to one school sixth form or sixth form college and a further education college from near where you live. However, you can live anywhere in the county and can attend any establishment and still receive transport support if you can get to a point on a core route that serves your chosen establishment. Apply now. You can always let us know if you wish to make changes to your application.
