Marking criteria for year 12 summer tasks

The marking of the 4 tasks -

- 1. Revision sheet on cells,
- 2. Enzymes letter
- 3. Plasma membrane poster
- 4. Glossary of Key words for PAG's

Should follow the guidelines for the ATL we will be required to provide after the initial assessment – this mark together with the baseline assessment and initial assessment should provide sufficient evidence to determine whether a student is suitable to be successful on the course.

ATL	Description
1	The student has successfully completed all 4 tasks to a high standard – showing a high level of effort, They have clearly demonstrated independent study and have clearly communicated their knowledge and understanding. Shows evidence of going beyond the tasks set in their independent study.
2	The student has completed all 4 tasks to a good standard with a good level of effort and has shown that they have followed the instructions for each of the tasks. They have communicated their knowledge and understanding.
	The student may not have completed all of the tasks – or not all of the tasks have been completed well. The effort is not to the level
3	required for a prospective A level student. Communication of their knowledge and understanding is not always clear and coherent.
	Tasks are poorly attempted or not at all. Level of effort is poor and no real evidence of them following the task instructions and
4	independent study. Communication is not clear.
