### Task1

  4. Clear contextual knowledge exhibited

#### **Structuring your response to essay questions.**

**Point** – should be short, concise and answer the question

**Evidence** – should come from the text analysed and be vividly described using media language terms

**Explain** – should be in depth, with multiple reasons how/why

**Theory** – should be appropriate and evident in the text analysed (this includes concepts/ideologies like Socialism or Liberal/Conservatism etc)

**Link to Real World** – should be based on the social, historical, political knowledge of the text.
