Daily Reminders

Remember to put your

Knowledge Organiser
into your school bag every day





Remember to bring a **drink** to school with your lunch, ideally this should be water or squash

Remember to wear your **face mask**. Spare masks are available from the Year Office if you need one.





Every school day, you should study 1 to 2 subjects from your knowledge organiser for homework lasting at least 1 hour in total. A timetable will be shared next half term to support students with planning of subjects to complete.

There is space in the booklet for you to record the subjects you have studied to make sure you are giving equal time to all of them and your parents are requested to sign off your homework each evening when you have completed the tasks.

You will need to bring your Knowledge Organiser to school every day as it will be checked regularly during form time and you will be regularly tested on the knowledge contained in the booklet during lessons and through quizzes on Show My Homework.











We have had a couple of issues related to social media use within the year group. I feel it's important to remind you of the legal ages for online social media and how you can support your child's safety whilst being online. I would recommend that you discuss your child's use of social media and check what they are doing.
