Dear Parent/Carer

Springwood High School currently remains open in-line with government advice. There have been no cases of coronavirus in either the staff or students. Should I be notified of any confirmed cases I will update you immediately.

School cannot provide work for individuals who have been kept at home, however homework is still being set using Show My Homework.
