Summer Task Title / Instructions:

<u>Task 1</u>

Macro Economics Summer Task Brief:

Springwood Sixth Form has formed its own political party called "The Springforwards." You have been asked to **write a report** to the government outlining the strategies you recommend they use to help the economy grow without further affects on inflation.

Think About:

- What strategies are the current political party in power is using currently to encourage the UK economy to grow (with examples)?
- Why have they been adopted and how should they work? Who are they aimed at? How can measure their effectiveness? minimum of 4
- What do you suggest the government should do once Covid 19 has passed to stimulate the economy?
- 1. Monetary policy
- 2. Fiscal policy
- 3. Supply Side policies
- How <u>your</u> strategies will help stimulate the economy (refer to macro-economic objectives- below). You should use data to show the current position of these objectives below and how they vary from the government targets.

 - o Economic Growth
 - \circ Inflation
 - o Balance of Payments
 - o Distribution of Income
- Why you believe other strategies are unhelpful
- How your policies may cause macroeconomic conflicts- the economic problem-which is the most important policy & why
